## **Brief Report of Prog.- 12**

## 10 Days National Workshop on

## Constructivist Lesson Planning and Teaching Strategies From 10<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> Feb., 2020

◆ The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha. New Delhi under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (MHRD), Govt. of India has organized 10 Days National Workshop on Constructivist Lesson Planning and Teaching Strategies from 10<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> Feb., 2020. The objectives of this workshop were to familiarize the participants with the concept of constructivist approach to teaching and to develop competencies for using constructivist teaching strategies and preparing lesson plans. The programme was inaugurated by Chief Guest Dr. Sachchidanad Joshi (Member Secretary, IGNCA, New Delhi) in the presence of the Vidyapeetha Registrar Dr. Alka Rai and Dean & Head, Faculty of Education Prof. K. Bharathbooshan followed by the welcome speech and backdrop note of the workshop by Project Head, Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj. The total participants registered in this programme were 44 out of which 04 left and 40 participants successfully completed the programme. The participants were from 03 states viz., Uttarakhand (05), Delhi (31) and Bihar (04). The programme was conducted through 40 distinctly designed sessions encompassing Inaugural, Induction, Technical, Hands-on-Practice, Sharing of experiences, Online Assessment, Feedback and Valedictory Sessions. Each day there were 4 sessions and the technical sessions were transacted on practice centric approach under the able guidance of highly experienced nine Resource Persons drawn from various reputed universities/institutions of the country. In the practice sessions the participants were assigned total of 18 tasks out of which 08 were individual and 10 were of group based type. The main themes covered in these sessions were-Constructivist Approach To Teaching & Learning, Discussion and Role Play, Problem Solving Cooperative Learning, Investigative Approach, Concept Mapping, Jig-Saw Strategy, Social Inquiry Approach, Project Based Learning, Experimental Learning, Critical Thinking and Case Based Pedagogy, Web Quest, Brainstorming, Creative Writing and Developing Constructivist Lesson Plan. In the end, online feedback about the Resource Persons for ensuring the effectiveness of the delivered lectures from the participants' point of view was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average was found to be 44%, 40%, 13% & 03% respectively. In addition to this, online feedback about the workshop was also taken on 10 points in five categories viz. Excellent. Very good, Good, Satisfactory and Unsatisfactory. The average percentage on all 10 points in five categories was found to be 60% in Excellent, 30% in Very good, 09% Good, 01% in Satisfactory and Nil in Unsatisfactory categories. The valedictory session was inaugurated by Chief Guest Prof. G.P. Thakur (Former Head & Dean, Dept. of Psychology, MGKVP, Varanasi, U.P.) in in the presence of the Vidyapeetha Registrar Dr. Alka Rai and Head & Dean, Faculty of Education Prof. K. Bharathbooshan. The Project Head welcomed the guests and presented the workshop report followed by the sharing of experiences by the participants. The programme ended with certificate distribution and vote of thanks.
