

## **03 Days National Workshop on Online Assessment Tools and Procedures**

**From 02<sup>nd</sup> to 04<sup>th</sup> March, 2020**

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, New Delhi under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (MHRD), Govt. of India has organized **03 Days National Workshop on Online Assessment Tools and Procedures** from **02<sup>nd</sup> to 04<sup>th</sup> March, 2020**. The objectives of this workshop were to acquaint & develop competencies for assessment tools and procedures, e-tools and to develop competencies for creating and using online assessment tools and procedures in teaching-learning process. The programme was inaugurated by **Prof. Nagendra Jha** (*Former Head & Dean, Faculty of Education, SLBSRS Vidyapeetha, New Delhi*) followed by the welcome speech and backdrop note of the workshop by **Project Head, Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj**. The total participants registered in this programme were 36 out of which 09 left and **27 participants** successfully **completed the programme**. The participants were from **04 states** viz., J&K (03) Uttarakhand (03), Delhi (20) and Kerala (01). The programme was conducted through **12** distinctly designed sessions encompassing Inaugural, Induction, Technical, Hands-on-Practice, Online Assessment, Feedback and Valedictory Sessions. Each day there were 4 sessions and the technical sessions were transacted on **practice centric approach** under the able guidance of highly experienced **four Resource Persons** drawn from various reputed universities/institutions of the country. The main themes covered in these sessions were- Hot potatoes, Playposit, Kahoot, Socrative, Google Forms, Class Marker, Quizziz, Mentimeter, Test MOZ and assessment through LMS Edmodo and Google Classroom. The tasks assigned related to the mentioned themes were submitted online by the participants. In the end, **online feedback** about the **Resource Persons** for ensuring the effectiveness of the delivered lectures from the participants' point of view was taken in 04 categories viz. **Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory** and the average was found to be **56%, 27%, 13% & 04%** respectively. In addition to this, **online feedback about the workshop** was also taken on 10 points in five categories viz. **Excellent, Very good, Good, Satisfactory and Unsatisfactory**. The average percentage on all 10 points in five categories was found to be **60%** in **Excellent**, **32%** in **Very good**, **06%** **Good**, **02%** in **Satisfactory** and **Nil** in **Unsatisfactory** categories. The valedictory session was inaugurated by *hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Vidyapeetha* **Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey** and *Former Head & Dean, Faculty of Education* **Prof. R.P. Pathak**. The Project Head welcomed the guests and presented the workshop report followed by the sharing of experiences by the participants. The programme ended with certificate distribution and vote of thanks.
