Brief Report of Prog.-02

03 Days National Workshop on Capacity Building through Action Research From 24th to 26th June, 2019

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, New Delhi under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (MHRD), Govt. of India has organized 03 Days National Workshop on Capacity Building through Action Research from 24th to 26th June, 2019. The main objective of this programme was to develop competencies related to designing and implementation of Action Research Projects. This programme was transacted through 12 distinctly designed sessions including Inaugural, Induction, Feedback and Valedictory Sessions. The *Dean & Head, Faculty of Education, Prof. K. Bharathbooshan* inaugurated the programme followed by background note about the programme by *Project Head Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj*. The total participants registered in this programme were 57 out of which 40 were called up but only 33 participants continued the programme. The participants were from 07 states viz., Jammu & Kashmir (01), Haryana (03), Delhi (17), Rajasthan (02), Uttar Pradesh (06), Maharashtra (03) and Madhya Pradesh (01). The various sessions of the programme were conducted under the able guidance of highly experienced four Resource persons from various reputed universities. The main themes covered in these sessions were- Introduction to Action Research, Solutions to Classroom based problems through Action Research, Designing Action Research based Project and Report Writing. Each topic taken-up in the session was followed by practice session in which participants were assigned individual/group based task work. The total of 06 tasks was carried out by the participants out of which 01 was of individual and 05 were of group based type. In the end, online feedback about the quality of lectures delivered by the Resource Persons was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average was found to be 57%, 23%, 15% & 5% respectively. In addition to this, online feedback about the workshop was also taken on 10 points in five categories viz. Excellent, Very good, Good, Satisfactory and Unsatisfactory. The average percentage on all 10 points in five categories was found to be 60% in Excellent, 38% Very good, 2% Good, Nil in Satisfactory and Unsatisfactory categories. In the valedictory session the Project Head presented the workshop report followed by the sharing of experiences by the participants. It was further followed by presidential address by Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey (*Vice Chancellor, SLBSRS Vidyapeetha, New Delhi*) and the programme ended with certificate distribution and vote of thanks.
