03 Days Online National Workshop on
Enhancing Digital Skills & Competencies
From 24th to 26th August, 2022

Brief Report

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized 03 Days Online National Workshop on Enhancing Digital Skills & Competencies from 24th to 26th August, 2022 which is the 05th programme of Phase-VI. The objectives of this programme were to familiarize with various digital apps, tools & softwares for teaching-learning; to give insight in the process of using various digital tools & software for teaching & to develop digital skills & competencies for teaching-learning. This programme was conducted in an online mode through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre **Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj** followed by the Presidential Address of *Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of our University*, **Prof. Murlimanohar Pathak**. The programme was transacted through 18 distinctly designed sessions comprising of inaugural, induction, 08 demonstrations based technical sessions, 03 Question & Answer and 03 self-practice sessions, 01 each viz. online assessment, feedback, sharing of experiences and valedictory sessions. **The registrations received for the programme were 46 and the same continued the programme successfully.** Out of 46 participants, 41 were from 17 states and 05 from 02 UTs. The participants from 17 states include Andhra Pradesh (02), Assam (01), Bihar (01), Chhattisgarh (01), Haryana (05), Jharkhand (03), Himachal Pradesh (01), Karnataka (01), Kerala (01), Maharashtra (01), Odisha (02), Punjab (01), Rajasthan (09), Tamil Nadu (04), Telangana (01) Uttar Pradesh (04) & Uttarakhand (03) while that of 02 UTs were Delhi (04) & Jammu & Kashmir (01). All the technical sessions were conducted under the able guidance of **07 Resource Persons** having expertise in the concerned area from various reputed institutions of the Country. The main themes covered in the programme were- Digital Approaches & Content Creation tools, Online PowerPoint Development, Digital Social Media Skills, Digital Data Visualization Skills, Skill of Using Online Content, Digital Data Analysis, Digital Collaborative & Interactive Skills and File Management Skills. The participants were assigned choice based **08** assignments based on the themes taken up in the technical sessions. An **online test** was administered where **59% of the participants scored above 50%**. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from the participant's point of view **online feedback about the Resource Persons** was taken in 04 categories viz. **Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory** and the average found was **74%, 21%, 04% & 01%** in the respective categories. In addition to this, **online feedback about the programme** was also taken on 10 points in five categories and the average percentage was found to be **72% Excellent, 25% Very good, 03% Good, 00% Satisfactory** and **00% Unsatisfactory**. In the valedictory session, the Director of the Centre welcomed the guests and presented the Programme report highlighting objectives, participation analysis, programme outcomes & feedback results followed by Presidential address by **Prof. Gopinath Sharma** (Ex-Head & Dean, JRRS University, Jaipur, Rajasthan). The programme ended with a vote of thanks followed by Shanti Path. E-Certificate and e-Photo album were mailed within a week to the successful participants after the completion of the programme.
